

(4) They Want You Dead Inside

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I am pro-life.

Not in the way that phrase has been politicized and narrowed. I mean something far more expansive. I am for life itself. The whole of it. The raw, unfiltered, devastating, transcendent experience of being human.

I am for the grief that breaks you open when you lose someone you love. For the rage that rises when injustice demands you stand. For the anxiety that whispers something is wrong before your conscious mind catches up. For the depression that descends when your soul has wandered too far from its purpose.

I am for the struggle. The confusion. The dark nights that precede transformation. The pain that cracks you apart so light can enter.

I am for the full catastrophe of human existence.

This is what it means to be pro-life. Not merely pro-birth. Not merely pro-heartbeat. Pro-LIFE. The entire arc of human experience from first breath to last, with all its terrible beauty intact.

To be human is to feel.

Not selectively. Not conveniently. To feel everything. To be capable of despair so deep it threatens to swallow you, and joy so fierce it brings you to your knees. To know loneliness that echoes in your bones and connection so profound words cannot hold it.

To be human is to struggle.

Against your limitations. Against injustice. Against the gravity that pulls you toward comfort and complacency. The struggle is not a design flaw. It is the curriculum. Every challenge you face is an invitation to become more fully yourself.

To be human is to be embodied.

To inhabit flesh that ages and aches and hungers. To be bound by time, shaped by place, limited in ways that force you to make choices. Your body is not a prison. It is an instrument through which consciousness experiences the material world. Every cell carries the signature of creation.

To be human is to be connected. Not networked - connected. It is the architecture of existence itself, the invisible lattice through which life recognizes life, through which light calls to light. Isolation is the lie. Separation is the weapon. Connection is what they must destroy before the rest of their agenda can proceed.

And it is under systematic attack.

You've heard that SSRIs are overprescribed. That the chemical imbalance theory was marketing, not science. That withdrawal is brutal and sexual dysfunction can last beyond the discontinuing of the drug.

All true. All surface level.

There's something deeper operating here. Something that explains why one in five women are now on these drugs. Why they're pushed on pregnant mothers despite the evidence I witnessed firsthand on an [FDA panel](#). Why children as young as seven are prescribed chemicals that produce effects their doctors either don't understand or won't discuss.

Most critics ask why SSRIs don't work as advertised. The more important question: What do they actually do?

When millions of people describe “feeling dead inside” - not sad, not numb, but *dead* - that's not a side effect. That's a primary effect. When they report spiritual disconnection that persists years after stopping, something specific is being targeted.

The more you look, the more a pattern emerges. And once you see it, you cannot unsee it.

These drugs don't just go to the severely ill. Severe and debilitating depression is a rare condition. They go to the young and the fertile and the emotionally alive. To college students drowning in a world that makes no sense. To new mothers overwhelmed by the weight of life they now carry. To teenagers who feel too much because that's what being a teenager means. To the grieving who won't stop crying because they loved someone worth crying for. Rock bottom. Life transitions. Developmental passages. The moments when humans are most cracked open, most vulnerable, most capable of transformation. Those are the moments they target.

I spent years thinking this was about money. It's not. Or not only. Look at how the machine actually operates: Pharmaceutical companies fund the research, design the trials to hide harm, ghostwrite the papers, and pay prestigious academics to attach their names. Journals publish these studies because pharma advertising pays their bills. The FDA approves the drugs because advisory panels are stacked with industry consultants.

Then comes the crucial step - professional organizations like the American Psychiatric Association, the American Academy of Pediatrics, and the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists issue treatment guidelines based on this corrupted evidence. These guidelines aren't suggestions. They become the standard of care. The legal definition of what a competent doctor must do. Now every physician in America is locked in. Follow the guidelines or face malpractice suits, insurance denials, loss of board certification. Medical schools teach the guidelines. Residencies enforce them. Continuing education reinforces them. The individual doctor's judgment becomes irrelevant. The machine has replaced it with protocol.

This is not corruption in the traditional sense - envelopes of cash changing hands in dark rooms. This is something more sophisticated. A self-perpetuating system where the science is manufactured, the guidelines are bought, and every downstream institution enforces compliance without understanding they're complicit in harm.

But there's something underneath all of this. Something more sinister. And it becomes impossible to ignore once you start asking the right questions.

Why are children as young as [seven prescribed SSRI drugs that increase suicidal ideation sixfold](#)? Drugs that were never proven to have any clinically meaningful benefit.

Why are teenagers medicated during the precise developmental window when their brains are learning to regulate emotion naturally?

Why are college students handed prescriptions the moment they struggle with the weight of becoming adults?

Why are veterans drugged into numbness when their nightmares are a sane response to what they witnessed?

Why are the elderly sedated through their final years rather than supported through the natural process of life completion?

Why are pregnant women given chemicals shown to alter fetal brain development?

Why are the grieving medicated before the body is cold?

Why the young? Why the old? Why those in transition? Why the ones cracked open by loss? Why the intuitive? Why the sensitive? Why those whose emotions burn hot because that's what human emotions are supposed to do?

They're not targeting dysfunction. They're targeting life itself. The moments when we feel most. The passages when we transform. The experiences that make us fully human.

What I'm about to show you isn't about pharmaceutical profits or regulatory failure or any of the standard critiques. To my knowledge, I am the only person talking about this publicly. I've searched. I've read the critical psychiatry literature, the health freedom writers, the researchers exposing these drugs. No one is discussing what I'm about to lay out.

The Anti-Human Agenda

To understand what's happening, you must first understand the philosophy driving it.

There exists a worldview, increasingly dominant among global elites, that holds human beings in contempt. Not hatred exactly. Contempt. The way eugenicists looked at the "unfit." The way colonizers looked at indigenous populations. A cold assessment that humans, as currently constituted, are obstacles to progress - problems to be managed, optimized, or bred out of existence.

This worldview has a name: transhumanism. But its roots are older and darker than the sleek futurism suggests.

It descends from eugenics - the early twentieth century movement that sorted humans into worthy and unworthy, that forcibly sterilized hundreds of thousands deemed unfit, that provided the intellectual architecture for Nazi Germany's racial hygiene programs. The eugenicists didn't disappear after World War II. They just learned to hide better.

When overt sterilization campaigns became impossible, they promoted birth control in the communities they wanted to disappear. When that moved too slowly, they funded abortion mills in those same neighborhoods and called it reproductive freedom. They poisoned the food supply with chemicals that disrupt hormones, degrade fertility, and produce the chronic illness that makes populations dependent and weak. They pushed pharmaceuticals that create more disease than they cure, each drug opening the door to three more. And now they've moved to technology - AI, genetic engineering, brain-computer interfaces - the final tools for remaking humanity in their image, or eliminating it entirely.

Different decades, different methods, same families, same foundations, same goal: dominion over human life itself.

It descends from technocracy - the belief that society should be managed by technical experts rather than democratic participation, that human affairs are engineering problems awaiting optimal solutions, that the messy unpredictability of free humans is an obstacle to efficient governance. The technocrat looks at human choice and sees chaos requiring control.

It descends from every ideology that looked at the mess and mystery of human existence and saw inefficiency rather than meaning.

The Materialist Prison

At its core, transhumanism rests on a metaphysical assumption: that matter is all there is. Consciousness is an accident. An emergent property of sufficient computational complexity. There is no soul, no spirit, no animating principle that transcends the physical. You are your neurons, nothing more. When they stop firing, you end.

From this assumption, everything else follows.

The transhumanist does not believe in the soul because the soul cannot be measured, manipulated, or monetized. Does not believe in inherent human dignity because dignity implies something sacred, and nothing is sacred in a universe of blind matter. Does not believe that suffering has purpose or that struggle produces growth because purpose implies meaning, and meaning implies a meaning-giver they've already ruled out of existence.

To the transhumanist, your emotions are chemical noise - serotonin, dopamine, cortisol sloshing around in a skull, signifying nothing beyond their evolutionary utility. Your intuition is pattern-matching errors, cognitive shortcuts that once helped primates survive the savanna but now produce irrational decisions requiring correction. Your spiritual experiences are neurological misfires, temporal lobe seizures dressed up in religious language. Your sense of free will is an illusion your brain generates after the fact to explain decisions already made by electrochemical processes you neither control nor comprehend.

You are not a child of God. You are not a unique expression of divine creativity. You are a biological algorithm running on outdated hardware. And algorithms can be hacked, rewritten, optimized, or replaced.

What makes this philosophy so dangerous is how it disguises itself.

It doesn't announce itself as contempt for humanity. It presents as concern. As progress. As care. We just want to reduce suffering. We just want to optimize wellbeing. We just want to help people reach their potential. We just want to solve the problems that have plagued humanity for millennia.

But listen carefully to how they define the problems.

Human emotion is a problem - too volatile, too unpredictable, leading to poor decisions and social instability. The solution: chemical management, emotional regulation technology, brain-computer interfaces that can modulate feeling in real time.

Human reproduction is a problem - too random, too uncontrolled, producing genetic variation that includes disease and disability. The solution: genetic screening, embryo selection, eventually artificial wombs that remove the inefficiency of biological mothers entirely.

Human cognition is a problem - too slow, too biased, too limited in memory and processing power. The solution: neural implants, AI integration, uploading consciousness to silicon substrates that can be backed up and improved.

Human mortality is a problem - the ultimate inefficiency, all that accumulated knowledge and capability lost to death. The solution: life extension technologies, cryonics, digital immortality.

Human spirituality is a problem - irrational attachments to invisible beings and ancient texts, source of conflict and resistance to progress. The solution: neurological explanations that reduce transcendence to brain states, chemical interventions that quiet the regions responsible for religious experience.

Notice the pattern. Every intervention targets something essential to the human experience. Every solution moves us further from what we've been and closer to something else entirely. And every step is framed as improvement.

The Voice of Davos

Yuval Noah Harari, Klaus Schwab's lead advisor at the World Economic Forum and frequent Davos keynote speaker, has become the chief articulator of this vision. His words are not hidden. They're broadcast. Celebrated. Applauded by the most powerful people on Earth.

"Humans are now hackable animals."

"Free will is over."

"We are probably one of the last generations of Homo sapiens."

This is not fringe speculation from some obscure academic. This is keynote address material at the annual gathering of global elites who shape policy, move markets, and architect the future of nations.

Harari speaks openly of "surveillance under the skin." Of humanity separating into "different species" by 2050. Of a "useless class" of billions made obsolete by artificial intelligence. Of the need for "global government" to manage these obsolete masses. He discusses "hacking humans" and rewriting "the code of life" as casually as others discuss quarterly earnings.

This is dark.

When asked what the useless class will do, he suggests drugs and video games to keep them pacified. He's not joking. He's describing what's already underway.

One in six Americans on psychiatric drugs. Epidemic levels of young men who've dropped out entirely - no career, no family, no future - numbing themselves with screens and pornography. Opioids hollowing out communities whose jobs were shipped away. Social media engineered by behavioral scientists to maximize addiction. Legalized weed and legal gambling expanding as wages stagnate and hope contracts.

The pacification infrastructure isn't a plan for the future. It's current policy. Harari simply says out loud what the data already shows: they're building a world where most humans are unnecessary, and they're already field-testing the chemical and digital sedation required to manage us into irrelevance.

His books are required reading for WEF initiatives and Great Reset architects. They don't hide their contempt for human sovereignty, human spirituality, or the belief that humans possess inherent worth beyond their economic utility. To Harari and those who fund him, you are an outdated algorithm. Hackable meat. A legacy system awaiting upgrade or deletion.

When the most powerful people at Davos hang on every word of a man who views humanity this way, we must understand something crucial:

This isn't philosophy anymore.

It's policy.

It's blueprint.

And they're implementing it now.

The Perfect Trojan Horse

This is why SSRIs are not a failed medicine. They are a successful weapon.

Consider what these drugs accomplish: they flatten emotional range until the depths and heights that make human experience sacred become inaccessible. They sever intuition, cutting people off from the inner knowing that warns when something is wrong. They create chemical dependency that binds millions to the pharmaceutical system for life. They damage the capacity for spiritual experience so thoroughly that "dead inside" has become the defining phrase of an entire generation of users. And they flow disproportionately to the young, the fertile, the sensitive, the intuitive - precisely those most capable of awakening, precisely those most likely to resist.

The genius of it: they've convinced generations that feeling less is feeling better. They've trained therapists to call it compassionate care when they refer clients to these chemicals - "take the edge off," "get through the hard time," "you don't have to feel this way." The message underneath: too much feeling is dangerous. Depth is disorder. The full range of human emotion is a medical problem. And it all unfolds celebrated as medicine, prescribed by trusted doctors, covered by insurance, advertised with soft piano and sunrise imagery as help.

The "mental health crisis" isn't a problem they're trying to solve. It's a precondition they're engineering. The transhumanist future requires humans who've forgotten what they are. Humans severed from the inner guidance that would make them recoil from what's coming. Humans numbed enough to comply with their own obsolescence.

But to understand why SSRIs are so effective at producing this disconnection, you need to understand what they actually attack at the biological level. Not serotonin. Something far more fundamental. Something ancient traditions recognized and modern science can now measure.

Your Cells Emit Light

Here is what they don't want you to understand about your biology:

You are a being of light. Literally.

Every living cell in your body produces photons - measurable electromagnetic radiation in the ultraviolet and visible light spectrum. Scientists call it ultraweak photon emission. The phenomenon was discovered in the 1920s by Russian biologist Alexander Gurwitsch and has been confirmed by researchers worldwide using photomultiplier tubes and specialized imaging technology.

The intensity is faint - between 1 and 1,000 photons per square centimeter per second. Too dim for the naked eye but measurable with precision instruments. The emission spans wavelengths from 200 to 750 nanometers. Every living cell produces it. When the emission stops, so does life.

Ancient traditions had words for this. Qi. Prana. The breath of God. They understood what modern biophysics now confirms.

Where does this light originate?

Mitochondria.

Your mitochondria are not merely the “powerhouses of the cell” generating ATP for energy. Research published in *Frontiers in Physiology* confirms they are the primary source of your body’s biophotonic emission. This light correlates directly with cellular health, metabolic function, and - emerging research suggests - consciousness itself.

[A 2023 study](#) demonstrated something remarkable: mitochondria in physically isolated containers can communicate with each other through non-chemical signaling. When researchers stressed mitochondria in one container, mitochondria in an adjacent but completely separate container altered their respiration in response. The communication appears to be light-based.

Your cells are talking to each other through light. And mitochondria are doing the talking.

This is the life force that animates you. And it is inherently self-healing.

Given the right conditions - clean air, real food, clean water, sunlight, movement, rest, connection, purpose - your body knows how to repair itself. This isn’t alternative medicine mysticism. It’s basic biology. Wounds close. Bones knit. Infections are fought. Cells regenerate. Toxins are cleared. The body tends toward wholeness when it isn’t being poisoned or starved of what it needs. This is the intelligence built into every living system, the same force that beats your heart without your conscious instruction and heals a cut while you sleep.

Disease, at its root, is disruption of this force. Misalignment with the natural order. Blockage of the light. When we poison our food with chemicals, we disrupt it. When we sever our connection to the earth and sun, we disrupt it. When we live in ways that contradict our design - sedentary, isolated, purposeless, disconnected from nature and each other and the sacred - we disrupt it. The body does not malfunction randomly. It responds to what we give it and what we withhold.

This is the pro-life position at its deepest level: trust in the life force. Trust that the body, given what it needs and protected from what harms it, will move toward health. Trust that symptoms are often signals, not enemies. Trust that the animating intelligence that built you from two cells knows something about healing that pharmaceutical executives do not.

They don’t want you to trust this. They need you to see your body as a broken machine requiring their interventions. They need you to see your emotions as chemical errors requiring their corrections. They need you to see your light as an accident of biology rather than the signature of the divine.

Because once you understand what you actually are, their drugs become absurd. Their interventions become insults. Their entire model collapses.

SSRIs Poison the Light

[Dr. Chris Masterjohn](#), a nutritional biochemist who specialized in mitochondrial function, exposed what the pharmaceutical industry hides. His research revealed that SSRIs create oxidative stress in mitochondria at rates comparable to severe genetic mitochondrial diseases. They don’t enhance serotonin. They deplete it while destroying the cellular machinery that generates your life force.

Now the clinical picture makes sense.

Emotional blunting. Not peace. Emptiness. Mothers who feel nothing holding their newborns. The full spectrum of human emotion flattened into gray nothing.

Feeling dead inside. This phrase appears constantly. Not sad. Not numb. Dead. As if the animating force has been extinguished. Because at the cellular level, it has.

Chronic exhaustion. Not tiredness that sleep fixes. Bone-deep depletion. The fatigue of cells that can no longer generate adequate life force.

Sexual dysfunction. Persisting for years after stopping - sometimes permanently. Sexual energy is creative energy is life force energy. All powered by mitochondria. All extinguished.

Brain zaps. The electrical storms accompanying withdrawal. Desperate firings of a system trying to restart normal function after chemical suppression.

They're not imagining it. Their cells have been chemically prevented from generating coherent light. The connection has been severed at the source.

Your Emotions Are Divine Intelligence

Here is what they pathologize:

Emotions are not just feelings. They are energy - measurable, physical, meant to move through you. The word itself reveals the truth: e-motion. Energy in motion. When this energy flows freely, you remain vital and alive. When it is blocked, suppressed, or chemically dammed, it doesn't disappear. It turns inward. It becomes disease.

Every ancient healing tradition understood this. Chinese medicine maps the pathways through which emotional energy flows - and the specific organs that suffer when specific emotions are blocked. Grief held in the lungs. Anger stagnating in the liver. Fear pooling in the kidneys. Modern science is catching up: we now know that suppressed emotions correlate with inflammation, immune dysfunction, chronic pain, and yes - cancer. The body keeps the score. Energy that cannot move must go somewhere.

And yet they've built an entire industry around blocking this energy, then treating the diseases that result from the blockage.

Anger. Not irrational rage, but justified, righteous anger - the kind that rises when you witness injustice, the kind that has fueled every revolution in human history. Anger is energy meant to move you toward action, toward boundary, toward change. They've pathologized the very emotion that makes resistance possible. Ask yourself: who benefits when an entire population is chemically incapable of outrage? When the energy that should fuel revolution is dammed up, medicated, labeled a disorder?

Sadness, and what we now diagnose as depression. These emotions arise from loss - loss of people, loss of meaning, loss of connection to purpose. Sadness is energy meant to move through you as grief, to cleanse what must be released, to signal that something fundamental is misaligned. Persistent sadness often means the energy is blocked - not that your brain is broken. It's guidance, not malfunction. Medicating it doesn't address the cause. It just dams the river and calls the flooding downstream a new diagnosis.

Anxiety. Yes, it's a fear response. Energy mobilizing you to fight or flee. But fear of what? We've been marinated in terror since birth - media cycles engineered for maximum alarm, screens pumping catastrophe into our nervous systems before we were old enough to walk. Pandemic counters. Terror alerts. Climate collapse. Political apocalypse. Every day, all day, for our entire lives. The energy of fear is activated constantly but has nowhere to go - you cannot fight a screen, cannot flee an algorithm. Then they diagnose the natural result of this psychological bombardment as a disorder inside you and hand you a prescription. The system manufactures your fear, traps the energy in your body, then sells you the chemical to numb your awareness of it while the energy continues to corrode you from within.

Grief. Love with nowhere left to go - the tax we pay for connection that ran deep enough to leave a wound. Grief is meant to be the heaviest energy, the slowest to move, because it honors the weight of what was lost. Rushing it, medicating it, pathologizing its duration is a form of violence against the soul.

These are not symptoms requiring correction. They are energy requiring movement. They are intelligence. The language through which your soul speaks to your conscious mind.

Block this energy with chemicals and it doesn't vanish. It calcifies. It becomes the autoimmune disease, the chronic fatigue, the cancer that "came out of nowhere," the slow deadening that people mistake for aging but is really the cumulative cost of a lifetime of feelings that were never allowed to flow.

I began by saying I am pro-life. Now you understand what that means.

It means protecting the full spectrum of human emotion from those who would flatten it into compliance. It means defending the struggle, the darkness, the holy discontent that drives transformation. It means recognizing that your cells emit light and that this light is under chemical attack. It means understanding that emotions are energy and that energy must move or it becomes disease. It means refusing to become what they need you to be: numb, disconnected, manageable, hackable.

To be pro-life is to insist on remaining fully human in an age that demands you become something less.

They are betting you won't. They are betting the drugs will work, the propaganda will hold, the disconnection will be complete before you notice what's been taken.
